If a class has a pattern, it will be posted morning of the show. Warm up is available in the Agriplex prior to each discipline.

**SHOW RULES**

**GENERAL RULES:**

This is an Open Show to include horses, ponies, VSE (very small equine, measuring 39" or less at the wither), mules, donkeys, junior and senior riders/handlers. "Open" means open to all sexes/ages of rider and breed/size of animal unless otherwise stated. All classes held indoors in the Agriplex – except for Trail which will be at the holding ring by Ring 2.

All riders, drivers, grooms and exhibitors that enter the ring **MUST** be current Horse Council B.C. members, other PSO or USEF members. A photocopy of the membership card or proof of membership **MUST** accompany the entry. If you have paid your HCBC membership but have not received a card, you may contact the HCBC office at 1-800-345-8055 and they will fax or email proof of membership to either yourself or the Show Secretary. This **MUST BE DONE PRIOR** to the show. Failure to do so may result in your entry not being processed.

**If qualifying for BCPHC or APHA; or BCQHA**, horse registration number must be on entry form (and copy of papers may be requested upon entry).

**BC PAINT HORSE FREE TROPHY (AWARD) PROGRAM & APHA PAC Approved:** Show secretary will track the points of the REGISTERED Paint Horses (APHA) in all classes. It is up to the exhibitors to check with secretary on the day of for accumulated points.

**HIGH POINT REGISTERED QUARTER HORSE AWARD** (Sponsored BCQHA): Show secretary will track the points of the REGISTERED AQHA in all classes. It is up to the exhibitors to check with secretary on the day of for accumulated points

**CHECK YOUR ENTRIES!** Mistakes are your responsibility. Please fill out all information required on the entry form and mail in no later than May 18th. A complete mailing address, phone number, email address (if available) is mandatory.

**DRIVERS** aged 16 years and over as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 will not be required to have a groom. Junior drivers must be accompanied on the carriage at all times while driving on the grounds, in the holding area, or show ring, by an adult who is driving in other classes at this show. All junior drivers must wear approved helmets.

**STALLIONS** may not be shown by anyone under the age of 18 years (as of January 1, 2018). All Stallions **MUST** be "manageable" and shown in a suitable bridle/headstall for Halter classes and while being led/handled on the grounds.

**ENTRIES CLOSE: MAY 18th, 2018** (postmarked no later than – **NO EXCEPTIONS**)

**If insufficient entries show will be cancelled.**

**POST ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON DAY OF SHOW at twice the price.** Entries taken up to start of Performance Classes.

## **CLASS INFORMATION**

Exhibitors are responsible for having their entries in the holding area before their class, and must enter the ring promptly when called.

Classes may be cancelled, combined or split at the discretion of the Show Committee.

No more than 8 riders to hand gallop at one time.

All Driving classes are for single hitch.

Headers, if necessary, may enter the ring when summoned by the Ring Steward. Headers are required to wear livery appropriate to the hitch or a clean, white smock. Clean jeans are acceptable, but NO sweat pants.

If, in the Whipper-In's opinion, a VSE, pony, horse, mule, donkey, rider or hitch is determined to be unsafe, it will be refused entry into the ring. And in the ring, if any of those hitches are deemed to be unsafe, they will be asked to leave the ring immediately.

Pneumatic tires and wire spoke wheels, as well as Combined Driving Competition vehicles will be permitted in the Pleasure Driving classes. Fine Harness, Viceroy or Gentlemen's Sidebar vehicles are NOT permitted in the Pleasure Driving classes.

**HELMETS:** All junior drivers and riders MUST wear an ASTM or BSI approved helmet with harness and chin strap while mounted or on a carriage, while on the show grounds and in the show ring. Elastic bands for chinstraps are not acceptable. This rule is in effect for all classes; Ridden, Driven, English, and Western. Western adults riders are asked (not mandatory) to wear helmets to set an appropriate example for our junior exhibitors

All protests must follow HCBC Rules. Where items arise not covered in the HCBC Rules, the Show Committee decisions are final.

No one may approach/communicate with the judge or enter the judging area without the express permission of the Show Manager.

## **FOOD CONCESSION TBA**

**STABLING:** Stalls are available at \$25 per night. All manure, hay and bedding must be stripped from the stalls and the area picked clean before leaving the grounds in order for the \$50 deposit (separate cheque) to be returned. There is a designated manure disposal site. A dumpster for garbage is also provided. Do not put garbage in the manure site.

**TRAILERING IN:** Exhibitors are encouraged to show out of your trailer. There is no charge for this but you MUST clean up all manure, bedding, hay and garbage from around your vehicle and trailer. NO SAWDUST OR SHAVINGS.

Abuse to any animal or to show staff will not be tolerated. Abuses will be reported to Horse Council BC and dealt with in accordance with HCBC rules.

A ticket will be given for the quantity of classes you choose to enter (no need to identify/register per class).

If you choose the DAY RATE (per horse/mule), you can enter any and all classes of your choice (except the BREED CHALLENGE, that is \$5 entry at the gate; winner takes half!).

Exhibitor numbers (for EACH horse/mule) will help identify if you are a 'ticket' exhibitor or a DAY RATE exhibitor; BUT... you must also hand in your ticket to Whipper-in to access your class – no exceptions.

**WAIVER**

I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution of Horse Council BC and the Rules of Horse Council BC (HCBC). It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sport involves inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless HCBC, BCIMHC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, landowners, volunteers, employees and their representatives.

**HELMET DISCLAIMER:** In the event that the above named person/s participates in a HCBC sanctioned competition where approved headgear is required for Juniors and all Drivers and persons on the carriage in driving classes or on the grounds, he/she will wear a properly fitted ASTM or BSI approved helmet. It is understood that Juniors or any exhibitor or groom in a driving class not meeting this requirement will not be permitted to compete at this competition.
